Attendance & Punctuality


If children are to get the greatest benefit from their education at St Paul's, it is important that they have good attendance and arrive punctually. As children grow and prepare for their next stages of education and employment they need to see good attendance and punctuality as important qualities that are valued by others and employers. We will do all that we can to encourage good attendance and punctuality. Where children are not conforming to our high expectations for attendance and punctuality we will put into place effective strategies to bring about improvement. This year we are re-introducing attendance and punctuality awards. Instead of just awarding 100% attendance certificates we will now have a tiered system of reward certificates aimed at promoting good attendance and punctuality.

Award	Attendance	Punctuality
Gold	Attendance is 100%	Always in school on time
Silver	Attendance is 98% or higher	Very rarely late to school
Bronze	Attendance is 96% or higher	Very rarely late to school

If your child arrives late at school we now ask Parents to come to the office to sign them in with a reason for the late arrival.

Mobile Phones/Smart Watches

The School Policy is that children are not allowed to bring mobile devices or wear smart watches for school. Only in exceptional circumstances may Year 6 apply for permission to bring a mobile phone. Pupils who do bring a mobile device must adhere to the requirements of the policy. Failure to comply will result in permission being withdrawn. We thank you for your support of the policy which is designed to ensure pupils safety.

Year 6 Parents - Admission to Secondary School

Any applications received after this date will be dealt with as a late application.

Year 6 Bikeability

On Monday 25th September and Tuesday 26th September, Year 6 will be

participating in a Bikeability training programme in school. Bikeability is the national cycle training programme supported and funded by the Department for Transport. The course builds the skills and confidence of children who can already ride. Bikeability can not only make children better cyclists - potentially for the rest of their lives - but can help with general confidence and independent thinking. All our Bikeability training is delivered by qualified, professional, DBS checked National Standard Instructors.
