#### **Reception Places – September 2024**

The online portal is now open for applications for Reception 2024. The closing date for application is **15<sup>th</sup> January 2024**. Please be aware that we require additional evidence such as baptismal certificates to accompany your online application. This should be brought to the school office before **Monday**.

#### Dinner Debts

A new policy has now been introduced and all debts must be cleared promptly. Thank you to those families who have been supportive of this new policy.

If your circumstances have changed, and you feel you may be entitled to **Free School Meal** please contact the school office who can check this out for you. Your child may be able to get free school meals if you get any of the following: Income Support, Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance, Income-related Employment and Support Allowance, support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999, Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190), Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit, Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

#### Attendance & Punctuality

Last Friday, we presented 113 attendance awards to children. We have also sent out letters to Parents where attendance has fallen below 90%. Certificates will be awarded again at the end of the Spring Term for those pupils who have **both** good attendance and good punctuality.
