Healthwatch – Greater Manchester

Healthwatch in Greater Manchester are undertaking research into the mental health and wellbeing of young people. This project is important because we know there are long waiting times for young people to be seen and we want to investigate how this is affecting them. Findings will aid decision-makers in statutory NHS and Care services as well as in the education and voluntary sectors, to effectively prioritise services. Healthwatch have also launched a survey aimed to gather personal experiences of young people, as well as a separate survey open to parents and carers for them to share their experience of supporting their children. Further stages planned as part of this project include focus groups and case studies capturing the experiences of families.
