School Meals

For those children in Nursery, Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 the cost of a meal is now £3.25 per day. Payments can no longer be made through the Tameside portal. All payments should now be made through the School Spider payment system and in line with our payment policy we ask that all meals are paid for in advance on a weekly, half termly or termly basis. Any applications received after this date will be dealt with as a late application.

School can then do a quick check to find out if you are entitled to Free School Meals.
